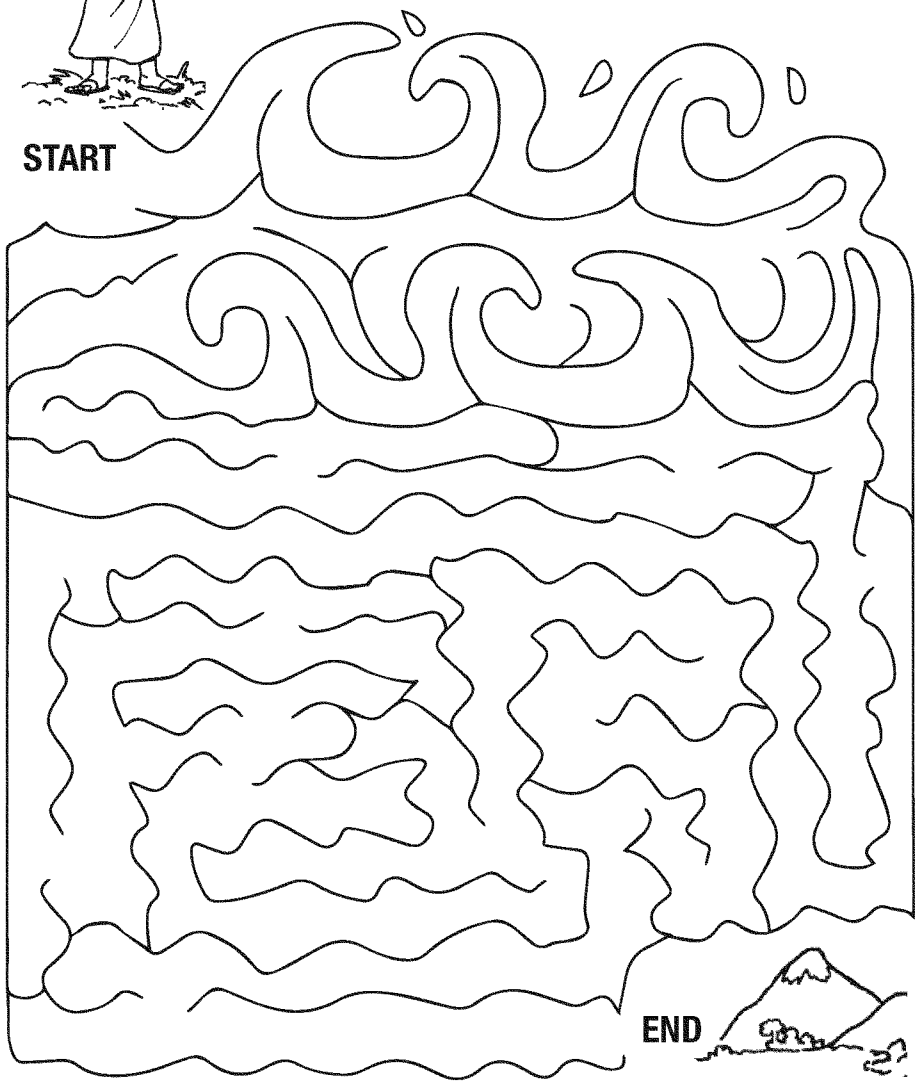

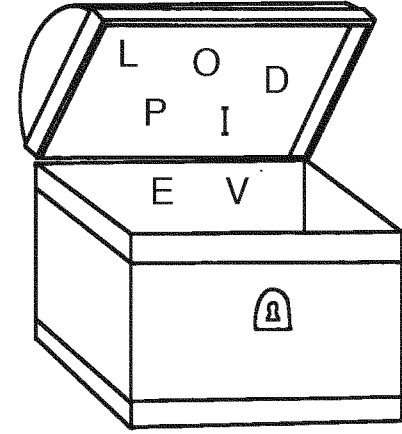


Help Joshua cross the river.

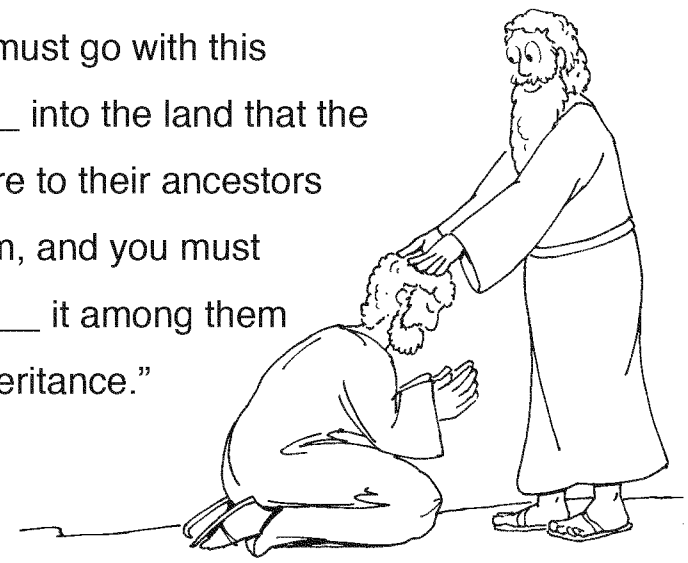
